

## **RULES OF COMPETITION**

**We want you to take a photo of a coastal scene that is important to you and to write a brief description explaining why you have chosen this scene.**

**What is your local coastal environment like? Which parts of it are important to you? How can you best show this through your photograph and writing?**

**Your work should reflect a personal attachment to the place you have chosen, with a strong focus on local identity.**

**Your photo can be taken either with a digital camera or camera phone, however digital camera is better. The most important thing is that you are creative and have fun.**

### **Terms and conditions**

- **This competition is open to any secondary school.**
- Teachers must register their school for the competition. Email [will@atlanticrising.org](mailto:will@atlanticrising.org)
- You must be a secondary school student to take part (12 – 18).
- Words must be written in English.
- Your photo must be between 200kb – 9Mb in size.
- Each student can only send **one** photo.
- Photos can be accepted in the following form: TIFF / JPEG / PNG / GIF.
- The winner and their school will be notified by email.

### **When sending the photo**

- Students must include their name / age / schools they attend
- Students should say where the photo was taken.
- Students should write the 50 words in the body of the email **NOT** as an attachment.
- We will confirm receipt of the photo with an email. There will be some short delay before it is added to the website.

### **Prizes for the winning photo**

- The overall winning photograph will receive a Nikon Coolpix Camera
- The school will receive a Nikon D60 SLR Camera with an 18-135mm lens.
- The winning school will receive a year's membership to the Royal Geographical Society Schools network.
- The winning UK school will receive a year membership to Rafi.ki.
- The winning photo will be displayed on the homepage of our website and also be shown in Geography Today and Geography in the News. The winning photo will also be noted in Geographical magazine.

### **Copyright**

- Photo copyright remains exclusively with the photographer.
- We will contact you in the event of a third party wanting to publish the photo. However we will not be able to police people directly copying it from our website (these will be low resolution versions of the original).
- Any money that comes from third parties publishing the photo will go to the photographer.
- It might be necessary to res-ize and crop the photo in order to fit it on our website. Due to the number of photos we will be processing, we will not be able to clear this with the photographer beforehand. However photos that are taken in 4x3 will not have a problem.
